The PACE George D. Echols Community Service Scholarship recognizes students who have made a positive impact in their schools or communities by demonstrating, exemplary leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship through service in the community as a volunteer. Applicants must be enrolled in high school and must be recommended for the award by a teacher, advisor or community leader. The recipient of this scholarship will receive a \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship.

The application is available on the PACE website at: www.paceleecounty.org, sent to high school counselors at Auburn High, Loachapoka High, and Opelika High schools and provided to PACE members for distribution to local churches.

Students must apply before the deadline, which is **March 31, 2024**. In order for applications to be considered, **ALL** components requested in the application process must be followed:

REQUIRED APPLICATION COMPONENTS

- All materials received by the scholarship committee should be **received** on or before the deadline.
- Materials to be submitted include:
 - 1.) an official transcript (Listing GPA and Class Rank),
 - 2.) one neatly completed application form,
 - 3.) one letter of recommendation from a current instructor in an academic subject area,
 - 4.) one sealed letter of recommendation from an adult member of your community who can attest to your positive actions in the community. Letter must be on official letter head and include a signature, title, email address and physical address, and
 - 5.) a typed one-page essay.
- The essay must be typed to fit one page, double spaced, and should use a font no smaller than 12-points.
 - The essay should discuss the applicant's efforts to give back to the community as a leader and through participation in service activities.
 - The essay should also communicate to the scholarship committee why this scholarship is needed and how it will be used to meet the applicant's educational and career goals.
- Finalist should prepare for a 15-minute personal interview with judges if requested. Judges will ask each candidate the same questions, however; follow-up questions may vary depending on each candidate's response.
