Each year, P.A.C.E. awards two scholarships in the amount of \$500 each to two deserving seniors who display financial need, leadership, high academic achievement, and outstanding community service. The application is sent to all high school counselors in Lee County. Our members also announce and post scholarship information in local churches for current high school seniors.

Please feel free to make copies and urge students to apply before the deadline, which is December 30, 2021. For applications to be considered,

ALL components requested in the application process must be followed:

REQUIRED APPLICATION COMPONENTS

All materials received by the scholarship committee should be postmarked on or before the deadline.

Materials to be submitted include:

- 1) an official transcript (Listing GPA and class ranking),
- 2) one neatly completed application form,
- 3) one letter of recommendation from a current academic instructor, school administrator, current employer, volunteer work supervisor, church, community leader, etc.
- 4) a typed essay.

The essay must be typed to fit one page, double spaced, and should use a font no smaller than 12-points.

- the essay should discuss the applicant's efforts to give back to the community as a leader and through participation in service activities.
- the essay should also communicate to the scholarship committee why this scholarship is needed and how it will be used to meet the applicant's educational and career goals.

- 3) One sealed **letter of recommendation** from either a current academic instructor, other school representative, employer, volunteer work supervisor or community leader.
- 4) A resume (**not exceeding one page**) that includes your extra-curricular activities, work experience, honors, and awards
- 5) A **one-page essay** which includes the following:
 - a. Explanation of how you utilize your skills and experiences to serve as a leader within your school and community.
 - b. Discuss how receiving this scholarship will benefit you.
